Show Info and Rules:

*Flat Fee Entries-Must include completed Flat Fee form, Entry form, copies of registration papers/membership cards (if entering breed classes) and full payment. See Flat Fee/Pre-Order form for stall reservation and refund policies.

*Any refunds issued will be done by check within 30 days of the last day of the show.

*Additional entries may be made at the gate, however the exhibitor must have completed an entry form, provided membership cards/registration papers and signed release statement prior to doing so. If signature not on file at the office prior to the gate entry an additional \$10.00 PER CLASS fee will be charged.

*Stall/Camper/Bedding splits not turned into the office by 12 noon Saturday will be billed in the entirety to the person who requested stalls and bedding.

*Camper/Trailers hooking up to electric/water must be parked in designated areas. All campers/trailers hooked up MUST fill out and return a camper permit form to the show office by 12 noon Saturday. Any camper/trailer parked in the camping area will be charged a hook up fee regardless if connected or not.

*General Schooling: AQHA equipment and animal welfare rules will be followed at all times in the schooling, trailer and stabling areas; it is the exhibitor's responsibility to be aware of these rules.

*All-Breed WTJ classes: WTJ open to any age/experience horse and exhibitor, any horse/rider combination entered in these classes cannot enter any class requiring a lope or canter.

*All-Breed Open & Youth classes: Open (any age horse/rider) & Youth (exhibitor 18 & under) classes open to any horse/pony regardless of breed/registration status. Open & Youth All-Breed classes are WTC/WJL.

* Non-negotiable Checks: A \$20 service charge plus bank fees, postage, other expenses & the face value of the check on any non-negotiable check due payable with cash or certified funds within 10 days of notification. Legal action taken after 30 days. Anyone with a bad check to Winning Weekends within the past 2 years will have entries processed on a CASH or CERTIFIED funds basis ONLY.

*Dogs must be leashed/crated at all times and dogs cannot be left unattended in barn aisles. Proof of current rabies vaccination must be available for inspection.

*Per NYS VAT laws #1265, all youth under 18 are required to wear an ASTM approved helmet whenever mounted. It is the parent/guardians responsibility to enforce this.

*Per fairground policy-all horses on the grounds (shown or not) must be registered with the show office and present a valid coggins and rabies certificate.

*Per fairground policy-all Chemung County parks (which include the Fairgrounds) are smoke free. Smoking is not allowed in and or around the barns, the indoor arena area or in the horse show offices.

*Per fairgrounds policy-No parking in the fire lanes, around barns or on apron in front of the pole barn, on roadway in front of indoor arena or between barns I and II. Parking will be enforced by the Chemung County Sheriff's Department and tickets will be issued.

*Per fairgrounds policy-Horses not to be tied to the fences/barns and must be bathed at the wash racks provided. No horses of any size allowed in any picnic area (new Barn III, lower campground or fenced area by the food booth) or in the picnic pavilion or in area around the office areas. All medical waste supplies must be disposed of in the designated containers located in the horse barns.

*Per fairgrounds policy-Motorized vehicles: golf carts, 4 wheelers, and other motorized vehicles may only be operated by licensed drivers and will be impounded if operated in an irresponsible or reckless manner. Any 4-wheeler on the grounds must be licensed.
